

## Getting rid of the “Exchange Server” message on GroupWise startup

You may find your users complaining that whenever they start GroupWise, a **Microsoft Exchange Server** window comes up prompting the user for Exchange Server information that they have no idea about. On clicking CANCEL the window goes away and GroupWise starts normally.

This usually happens after a recent installation or re-installation of the GroupWise client, and is caused by the installation software adding the Microsoft Exchange Server to the GroupWise mail profile.

Quite obviously the Microsoft Exchange Server is totally superfluous. To get rid of it and get rid of that annoying window, do the following :

- Close GroupWise.
- Close GroupWise Notify (right-click on the Notify World Globe next to the time in the bottom right-hand corner of your screen, and choose “Exit”).
- Start \ Settings \ Control Panel \ Mail and Fax.**
- Highlight **“Microsoft Exchange Server”**.
- Click on REMOVE.
- Click OK.
- Close the Control Panel.
- You’re done.** From now on GroupWise will start without that annoying and unneeded “Microsoft Exchange Server” window.

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
